

Attempting Reentry

Pedigree Analysis

Attempting Reentry is that rarest of racing opportunities: a very well-bred, sharp-looking, light-on-her-feet filly at a reasonable price.



Her sire is the Maryland-based Not for Love. Not for Love is the top sire in the mid-Atlantic region and, arguably, the best sire in the country standing outside of Kentucky. In each of the last seven years, he's led non-Kentucky stallions in progeny earnings, typically ranking in the top 20 of all stallions. His progeny have earned nearly \$50 million. Sixty-six of his offspring — fully nine percent of them — have won stakes races and another 55 (seven percent) are stakes-placed.

Not for Love has dominated the Maryland Million races, with at least two winners in each of the last eight years and four in 2009. This statistic is testament not only to his excellence but also to his versatility. Not for Love's offspring go long and short, dirt and turf.

Not for Love is also known for moving his mares up. When mares are bred to him, the resultant offspring are, statistically, better than when the same mares are bred to other stallions. So it's no surprise that Not for Love's two year-old average sales price is more than \$120,000.

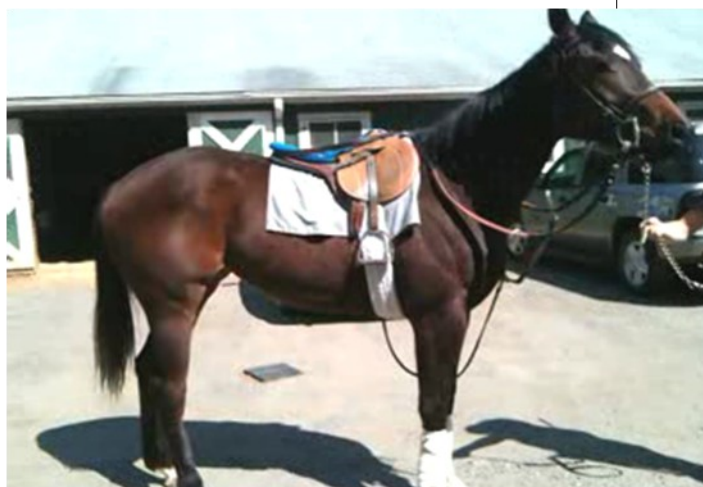
Attempting Reentry's dam is Set to Fly, by the esteemed broodmare sire Re-launch. Set to Fly, out of the stakes-winning Bravest Roman mare Bravest Miss, was a stakes winner on the track and has been an exceptionally successful broodmare. She's had 11 offspring reach racing age — and all 11 are winners!

Her offspring include stakes winner Raghbir, stakes-placed Polish Missile, and three other horses with more than \$80,000 earnings. Also in the mix are two full siblings to Attempting Reentry, both of which are multiple winners.

Looking farther back in the pedigree, both Set to Fly's dam — Bravest Miss — and her granddam — Missile Belle, by Missile — were stakes winners who became successful broodmares. They gave birth to eight and ten winners, respectively.

Attempting Reentry has no inbreeding within four generations; she is 4s x 5s to Native Dancer and 5 x 5 to Nasrullah.

She is Breeders' Cup-nominated, Maryland Million eligible, and a registered Maryland-bred.
